Judy Matthews: {AS WRITTEN BY JUDY} I have been in so much pain from July 1 to March 4. I had my back fusion November 14 and I thought that was going to make me better immediately. It didn't. As you know health care always asks for a pain rating of 0-10 and my 10 was equal to 15 or 20. I was in a skilled nursing facility for 3 weeks at the end of December because the pain was so intense, and my left leg stopped working. When I got up March 4, my pain level was down to 1 or 2 and now I have no pain at all. Lost a lot of leg muscle due to lack of activity so it will take a long while to get that built back again. I have home care coming in for PT, OT, and bath aide. They have helped me get in and out of the motor home as well as the routine home exercises. I now walk with my walker and hope to get to a cane soon—but you all have seen me go through those stages for many of my other joint issues. This has certainly been a long spell with pain so severe. We will be at the 1st rally in Galax.

Steven Bowers has recovered nicely from his knee surgery and expects to receive a "final" release from his doctor.

We continue to lift Cheryl up in our prayers. Bill says she is not leaving the house now so we will not be seeing them at rallies this year. We miss you both and send you hugs and prayer
